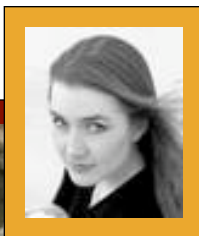

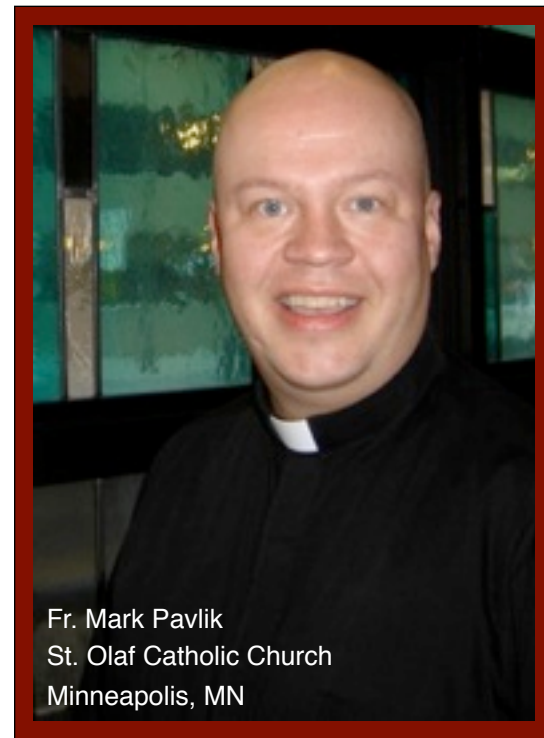

June 13, Sunday

Depart USA for Israel

June 14, Monday

Arriving late afternoon in Tel Aviv, we'll transfer to our kibbutz hotel on the shores of the **Sea of Galilee**. Overnight Galilee. **D**

June 15, Tuesday

We'll begin the day at an archeological site at **Caesarea Maritima** with Roman, Byzantine and Crusader period ruins and walk in the **Shuni Water Tunnel**, then on to view the Jezreel Valley from **Mt. Carmel**. Pass by the tel of **Megiddo** on the way to **Nazareth** to see Mary's home and celebrate Mass at the **Church of the Annunciation**. Visit **Nazareth Village** to experience 1st Century living. Overnight Galilee. **B D**

June 16, Wednesday

After viewing the recovered 1st century **fishing boat at Kibbutz Nof Ginosar**, we will cross the Sea of Galilee via boat to **Capernaum** for Mass upon the site of **St. Peter's House** where Jesus' ministry was based, followed by a visit to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**. Then we'll drive north to **Caesarea Philippi** near Mt. Hermon, site of Peter's confession of Jesus as Messiah with optional hike at ancient **Tel Dan**. Return to Galilee via Golan Heights. Overnight Galilee. **B D**

June 17, Thursday

We visit **Sephoris**, a large archaeological site in the Galilee and nearby ancient tombs. Then on to **Mt. Tabor** for Mass at **Basilica of the Transfiguration**. After visiting the ancient synagogue of **Bet Alpha**, we'll stop to swim in the natural springs of "**Sachne**." Following the **Jordan Valley** route to

the **Jericho Road** through the **Judean Wilderness** to **Jerusalem**, we'll share the traditional Jewish blessing ceremony upon entering Jerusalem while overlooking the Old City. Overnight Jerusalem. **B D**

June 18, Friday

We'll begin the day on the **Mt. of Olives**, walking down to **Dominus Flevit** (Jesus wept) church ending at the **Garden of Gethsemane** for Mass at the **Church of All Nations**, the Basilica of the Agony. Crossing the Kidron Valley to oldest part of Jerusalem, the **City of David**, we'll see the **Pool of Siloam** and walk through **Hezekiah's Tunnel**. In the afternoon, a visit to **Bethlehem's Church of the Nativity** will be followed by a stop at **Shepherd's Fields**. Jewish Sabbath begins. Overnight Jerusalem. **B D**

June 19, Saturday

We'll visit **St Anne's** Basilica and the **Pools of Bethesda**, walk the **Via Dolorosa**, carrying the Cross with meditation at each of the Stations of the Cross, and celebrate Mass at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. Next, we'll go to the southern steps of the **Temple Mount** before heading to **Modern Jerusalem** to see the model of 1st century Jerusalem and **Shrine of the Book** at the Israel Museum. Then, a stop at Knesset and Menorah. Overnight Jerusalem. **B D**

June 20, Sunday

Mass at **Baptismal site of Jesus**, then take a cable car to top of **Masada** to tour Herod's fortress and see ruins of Byzantine church. "Swim" in the **Dead Sea**, hike to **Ein Gedi** Falls where David hid from King Saul. See **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Overnight Jerusalem. **B D**



June 21, Monday

Mass at **St. Peter in Gallicantu** starts our day, then on to **Mt Zion** to view King David's Tomb and the **Upper Room**. We'll return to the Old City to the Jewish Quarter to see the **Burnt House**, **Western Wall** and the **Rabbinical Tunnel**. **Yad Vashem** option or **Tel Maresha**, we'll see the caves and possibly participate in "dig!" Farewell dinner in Abu Gosh. Overnight Jerusalem. **B D**

June 22, Tuesday

We'll tour **Ein Kerem**, John the Baptist's home, followed by a stop at **Mini-Israel** to put it all in perspective. We'll celebrate Mass at the **Church at Emmaus** before visiting **Elah Valley**, where David slew Goliath, and ancient port city of **Jaffa**. Those departing for US go to the airport for a late departure. **B**

(Those on Eilat extension depart for Bedouin overnight.)

June 23, Wednesday

After clearing customs in US, continue home on connecting flights.

June 24-25, Thursday/Friday

Stay in Eilat and enjoy the beach or take these optional excursions:

Day tour to Petra in Jordan

Day tour to St. Catherine's Monastery (Mt. Sinai)

June 26 - 27, Saturday/Sunday

Return to Tel Aviv then depart for US.
